Sir/ Madam,

In continuation to this office letter No. 34(41)(UG)/2012-Med./Bih/111334, dated 14.06.2012. I am directed to inform that compliance verification assessment of the physical and the other teaching facilities available for continuance of recognition of MBBS degree granted by B.N. Mandal University, Madhepura in respect of students being trained at Katihar Medical College, Katihar was carried out by the Council Assessors on 19<sup>th</sup> June, 2012. The said compliance verification assessment report has been considered by the Board of Governors at its meeting held on 20.06.2012. The Board of Governors decided that recognition of MBBS degree granted by B.N. Mandal University, Madhepura in respect of students being trained at Katihar Medical College, Katihar be continued restricting the number of admissions (60) students per year.

In addition to above, this is further to inform you that while making admissions of your college to MBBS course it shall be ensured that:

- (i) No admission is permitted beyond the sanctioned intake capacity;
- (ii) Selection of Students to the Medical College is in accordance with the requirements laid down in the Graduate Medical Education Regulations, 1997;
- (iii) No admission is permitted beyond the cut-off date.

It shall be incumbent upon the Medical College that the information relating to admissions should be submitted within a fortnight of closure of admissions to the Council. Any failure to submit the information within this time limit would be construed that the admissions in the College were not in accordance with the statutory requirements, thereby enabling the Council to proceed in accordance with law against the College.

It is further to inform you that your institution is fully responsible to fulfill and maintain norms including the infrastructure both physical and human resource, teaching faculty and clinical material etc. throughout, as stipulated in Regulation of Medical Council of India. In case false/wrong declaration or fabricated documents have been used for procuring the approval of Continuation of recognition by the Board of Governors and the said misconduct is brought to notice or comes to the knowledge of MCI at any stage, your institution is not liable to be considered for approval of continuation of recognition with the

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
