# Admission to Post Graduate Degree & Diploma Courses 2018

Katihar Medical College is a postgraduate medical education institute established in 1987 by Al-Karim Educational Trust, Patna. Initially MBBS course was introduced and later in 2006 postgraduate courses were introduced. The college imparts training in MBBS course as well as MD/MS/Diploma courses in different specialties of medical sciences. The admissions in both the undergraduate and postgraduate courses are offered to candidates who have qualified in NEET examination in order of merit. Candidate seeking admission has to appear in counselling conducted under the extant rules, regulations and Court orders by the State of Bihar or other through their appropriate authorities.

### 1. DURATION OF COURSES:

Duration of Degree courses shall be of three years and duration of diploma courses shall be of two years. Provided that in the case of students having recognized two years diploma course in the same subject, the period of training shall be two years.

### 3. QUALIFICATION & ELIGIBLITY FOR ADMISSION IN POST GRADUATE COURSES:

### 3.1 **EDUCATIONAL**:

**ELIGIBILITY:** The candidate shall posses recognized MBBS degree or equivalent qualifications and should have obtained permanent registration with the Medical Council of India or any of the State Medical Councils or should obtain the same within one month from the date of his/her admission, failing which the admission of the candidate shall be cancelled. In the case of a foreign national, the Medical Council of India may, on payment of the prescribed fee for registration, grant temporary registration for the duration of the postgraduate training restricted to the medical college/institution to which he/she is admitted for the time being exclusively for postgraduate studies. Temporary registration to such foreign national shall be subject to the condition that such a person is duly registered as medical practitioner in his/her own country from which he/she has obtained his basic medical qualification and that his/her degree is recognized by the corresponding medical council or the concerned authority.

### 3.2 **AGE LIMIT:**

There is no age limit for admission in PG courses.

### 3.3 **COUNSELLING:**

- (i) The candidates in order of merit will be called for Counselling and for verification of original documents and identity by personal appearance. The counselling will be performed and the placement will be done on merit-cumchoice basis. No change in the choice will be allowed later on. The candidate coming late during counselling may be considered but placement will be done only on the existing vacancy at the time.
- (ii) Dates and venue of counseling by personal appearance and/or online will be notified by the **Government of Bihar** through its appropriate authority i.e. Bihar Combined Entrance Competitive Examination Board, Patna.
- (iii) The candidates should bring their NEET Admit Card, Call letter and other related documents including rotatory internship completion certificate, Printout of NEET Result, Photocopy of NEET Admit Card, Photocopy of ID Proof (Aadhar Card), Photocopy of PAN Card (Self), Photocopy of PAN Card Father & Mother/Guardian, 10<sup>th</sup> Pass Certificate, 12<sup>th</sup> Pass Certificate, MBBS Passing certificate, Permanent Registration, Mark sheet of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> Prof. MBBS course, Admit Card of 3<sup>rd</sup> Prof. MBBS Part-II course, College Leaving Certificate, Attempt Certificate, Character Certificate, No Objection Certificate from Employer (if any), all in original, in support of their eligibility.
- iv) A candidate will be asked to exercise his/her option for the Course from among those available at his/her merit serial after his/her original certificates/documents and identity are duly verified. Thereafter necessary order will be issued the same day of the counselling for allotment of the Course on merit-cum-choice basis as opted by him/her provided he/she has been found eligible in all respects.
- (v) A candidate will have to join the course within the date mentioned in his allotment letter with all necessary documents and requisite fee etc., failing which his/her candidature may be cancelled.
- (vi) Candidates belonging to General category have to secure at least 50 percentile marks, candidates belonging to SC, ST, EBC & OBC category have to secure at least 40 percentile marks and for persons with disability have to secure at least 45 percentile marks in the NEET-PG 2018, in order to fulfill the minimum performance criterion, as fixed by the Medical Council of India, to be eligible for admission in any Post Graduation course. No weightage will be given for rural or any other services. Only the marks obtained in the test will be taken into consideration. Any subsequent order by Medical Council of India/Govt. of India/Judicial Order regarding minimum qualifying criteria will be applicable.
- (vii) No candidate will be permitted to pursue and complete more than one course at the same time.
- (viii) No candidate will be enrolled for two courses simultaneously i.e. as a regular student for one course and as an exstudent for the other course.
- (ix) A candidate who has passed a Post Graduate degree course will not be permitted admission in diploma course of the same subject.
- (x) If a candidate has been admitted in a P.G.Degree/Diploma course in any speciality on the basis of an earlier P.G. Medical Entrance Test, then he/she may be allowed to appear at the current P.G. Medical Entrance Test and also in the counselling based on the same, but will not be eligible for admission in a P.G. Degree /Diploma course of another speciality unless:-
- (a) He/she resigns and vacates the seat of P.G. Degree/Diploma course against which he/she has been admitted earlier, within seven days of receiving of the admission order on the basis of current NEET-PG 2018.
- (b) He/she returns all the pecuniary benefits taken thereof for the earlier course, and
- (c) He/she is liable to pay compensation for leaving the earlier course if the final decision regarding the same is made by the appropriate authority before the commencement of the counselling based on the current NEET-PG 2018.

### 4. TRAINING

- (i) All the candidates called for counselling, if selected, shall have to be registered with Bihar Council of Medical Registration / Medical Council of India within one month from the date of the admission in P.G. Course and will also have to register with the University concerned within the prescribed period by the University. The registered candidates will undergo whole-time training for 3 years/2 years for degree and diploma course respectively from the date of their admission.
- (ii) The compulsory Rotatory Internship must be from a Hospital/Institution approved and recognized by the Medical Council of India.
- (iii) No admission or readjustment will be done after the last date of admission as fixed in compliance with the requirement of Medical Council of India. Thereafter, the seats remaining vacant, if any, shall be treated to have lapsed. No transfer/migration will be permitted after admission.
- An admitted candidate on the basis of the counselling of NEET-PG 2018 shall automatically forfeit his/her claim to continue in the previous P.G. Course for which he/she was originally registered. His name registered for that P.G. Course will be cancelled and upon his/her admission to the new P.G. Course on the basis of NEET-PG 2018, he will have to get registered with the university concerned for that P.G. Course only and he has to refund the entire amount of stipend already paid to him for the previous P.G. Course to the previous Institution and a certificate to this effect is to be produced at the time of admission to the new course, allowed to him.
- (v) Name of the scholar who remains absent continuously for more than two month may be deleted from the rolls of the college.

### 5. Photograph to be submitted:

Recent, front view, high contrast black & white passport size Photographs (see Example below) snapped with a placard indicating the candidate's full name and the date (snap taken NOT earlier than 01.06.2017) must be pasted (do not staple) at proper places provided in the Application form.

### 6. FEE STRUCTURE

(i) The annual fee for Postgraduate Degree and Diploma Courses are payable annually at the beginning of academic year i.e. May. The annual fee structure for different subjects & courses are given below:

Further, candidates seeking admission to PG Degree Courses with recognized diploma qualification in the same subject shall be required to pay tuition fee equivalent to the fee of three y e a r s PG Degree Course. The fees for the additional one year, during which period the same seat will remain vacant, is to be paid in two equal installment during commencement of the two academic years of the course.

- (i) At the time of the admission while paying the college fee for 1<sup>st</sup> year through Bank Draft, the candidate shall also have to furnish Bank Guarantee / Bond for payment of college fee for the remaining period of the course
- **(ii) HOSTEL**: The rent for hostel accommodation is Rs. 1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lac Fifty Thousand) per annum compulsory.
- (iii) Security Deposit: All candidates are required to deposit Rs. 1,50,000/- as security deposit at the time of admission. This amount is refundable and shall be refunded after deducting dues, if any, after passing out.

### 7. ACADEMIC SCHEDULE

- The duration of Post Graduate Degree Course is 3 years and Post Graduate Diploma Course is 2 years.
- Each Degree candidate has to submit a thesis before 6 months of final examination on the basis of a synopsis to be submitted within a stipulated period after admission and to be approved by the proper authority.
- Final examination for Degree Course will be conducted by the University at the end of 6<sup>th</sup> term, i.e., before completion of 3 years after admission.
- Final examination for diploma course will be conducted by the University at the end of 4<sup>th</sup> term, i.e., before completion of 2 years after admission.
- All the candidates joining the Post Graduate training programme shall work as full time residents during the period of training and shall attend not less than 80% of the training imparted during each academic year including assignments, assessed full time responsibilities and participation in all facets of the educational process.
- A postgraduate student of a postgraduate degree course in broad specialities would be required to present one poster presentation, to read one paper at a national/state conference and to present one research paper which should be published/accepted for publication/sent for publication during the period of his postgraduate studies so as to make him eligible to appear at the postgraduate degree examination.
- Maintenance of logbooks and participation in periodical assessment is compulsory.
- It is compulsory for all postgraduate students joining the courses to stay inside the campus during the entire duration of course to fulfill requirement of full time residents as prescribed by MCI. Certificate of Junior Residency will not be issued if the student is found not residing inside campus.
- It is mandatory for all students to fulfill above conditions and also other conditions prescribed by MCI/Appropriate authority to be eligible to appear in University Examinations.

### 8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS to Curb the Menace of Ragging:

The M.C.I. has issued regulations to curb and control the menace of Ragging in educational institute (Notification No. MCI-34(1)/2009-Med./25453 dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2009 as amended till date). The candidates and their parents are to submit undertaking as provided in these regulations at the time of admission and every year subsequently. The undertaking is to be submitted online and printout is to be submitted in college office.
